Film- und Fernsehwissenschaftliches Kolloquium (FFK) is a specialized conference which is hosted annually since 1988 at various film or media studies departments. Traditionally functioning as a forum for graduate and post-graduate students the conference aims at refining relevant film, television and/or media studies' topics. In 2016 the FFK will take place at the University of Bayreuth for the first time.

The Bayreuth media studies department is looking forward to host the FFK 2016 and we are inviting all researchers in the areas of film, television and media studies to present and discuss their research projects (i.e. master thesis, dissertations, post-doc studies). We are planning to publish the papers.

Presenting – Papers and Panels

Papers and Panels are not thematically limited, but we welcome coherent pre-constituted panels. Individual paper presentations are limited to max. 20 minutes. Panels with 2-3 papers will have a time slot of 90 minutes including the discussion.

Registration

- *Presenters* can register by sending their personal data (name, institution, contact details), a short biography (max, 500 characters) and a paper abstract (titel, short description, max. 2000 characters).
- *Panels* can register by sending the personal data of one responsible participant and an abstract (including names and contact details of chairs and presenters, max. 3500 characters).
- *Persons who want to attend the conference without a presentation* can register by sending their personal data (name, institution, contact details).

All registrations (as .doc- or .rtf-documents) should be sent to ffk2016@uni-bayreuth.de by **15th of Januar 2016**. All registered participants will receive further information regarding the conference's schedule via mail.

Conference fee for presenters and participants

- conference fee for participants presenting a paper or chairing a panel: 30,00€
- conference fee for participants without a presentation: 20,00€

The conference fee is to be paid in cash upon registration at the conference venue.
