Gameboy

So not!

1941
Gunpei Yokoi, creator of the Gameboy, co-creator of Donkey Kong, producer of the Metroid series, several Nintendo toys and mentor of Shigeru Miyamoto at Nintendo is born on September 10, 1941

1960
Gunpei Yokoi creates Nintendo's first handheld game system: The Game & Watch.
The first game is called Ball, which features a guy who has to keep balls up in the air.

1989

Only nine years after the development of Game & Watch, Gunpei Yokoi and Nintendo Research and Development 1 create the Game Boy.

Nintendo GAME BOY™

It uses a Z80 processor, a green LCD screen, D-pad, two fire buttons, and a removable game cartridge system.

Helped by Tetris, the game cartridge that came bundled with the system, it became an instant success which dominated console sales for decades to come.

1995
Making their cash cow, Nintendo re-introduces their original Game Boy in different colors. This practice would become the norm with future hardware releases.

1996

The Game Boy Pocket used two AAAA batteries for 10 hours of gameplay. Instead of the green display, this model gets a true black and white LCD display.

1998
The Game Boy Color appears, with a limited color display, two times the processor speed, three times the memory, and still no backlighting. It was the equivalent of an NES.

2001

The Game Boy Advance is the first significant platform change in years, with a 32-bit ARM processor and a Z80 for backward compatibility.
The power of a SNES, but still no bloody backlighting.

1997
Game Boy Light, with a light-up display, debuts in Japan

2005

The Nintendo Game Boy Micro is the second major redesign of the console. It was also the last and perhaps the best version of the mythical console yet, with a tiny—but extremely usable—form factor, standard stereo jack, and a brilliant screen. It was discontinued in 2007, incapable of surviving the Nintendo DS-mania that started the year prior to its release.

2006

The iPod looking Nintendo DS Lite addressed some of the complaints about the original model, making it more compact and prettier while adding better screens and extending the battery life.

1889
Nintendo is founded by Fusajiro Yamauchi to make and sell playing cards.

1941
Japan attacks Pearl Harbor, enters World War II on the Axis side

1945
Germany surrenders. Hitler kills himself and then gets burned without ever having played a Gameboy
Japan surrenders unconditionally.

1950
1952
Shigeru Miyamoto, creator of Mario, Zelda, Star Fox, F-Zero, Pikmin, and Nintendo, co-creator of Donkey Kong, and maximum Pope of Gaming is born on November 16, 1952

1979
Jay Smith, the guy who created Vortex, designs the Microvision, the first handheld console with cartridges.

1981
Shigeru Miyamoto and Gunpei Yokoi build the Donkey Kong arcade, the beginning of a new era in video games.

1980

1989
Atari Lynx debuts. It's the world's first handheld with a color display but it falls against the Game Boy.

1990
Sega introduces a more advanced console called the Game Gear, basically a portable Master System with a color LCD screen. The system couldn't compete with the Game Boy's price and battery life. It died seven years later.

1990
Gulf War starts. A Game Boy is badly damaged but it still works, showing its durability.

1995
Virtual Boy is introduced. It falls, getting cancelled one year later.

2000

2003
The Game Boy Advance SP solves at last one of the main complaints about the handheld. It adds backlighting. It also has a very elegant and widely liked clamshell design, making it a lot more convenient to carry than the big Game Boy Advance.
It's still not perfect: it requires an adapter to use regular headphones.

2004

The Nintendo DS debuts, changing the way people interact with consoles and opening gaming to everyone thanks to its touch screen controls.
Featuring two screens—following on the Game & Watch tradition—the Nintendo DS was an instant success. It also killed the Game Boy.

The Nintendo DS has a bigger screen than the Game Boy Advance plus two 3 megapixel cameras and an auto-memo.

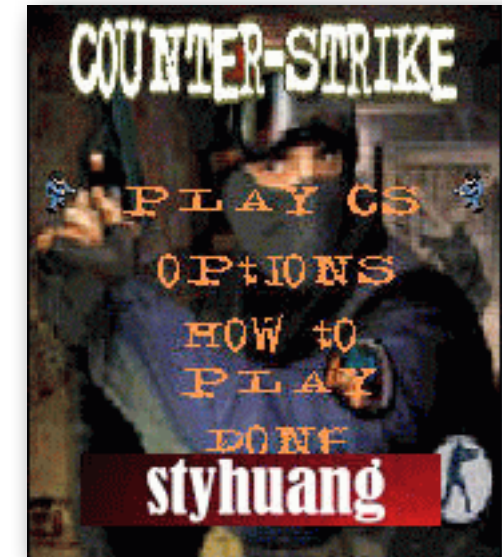

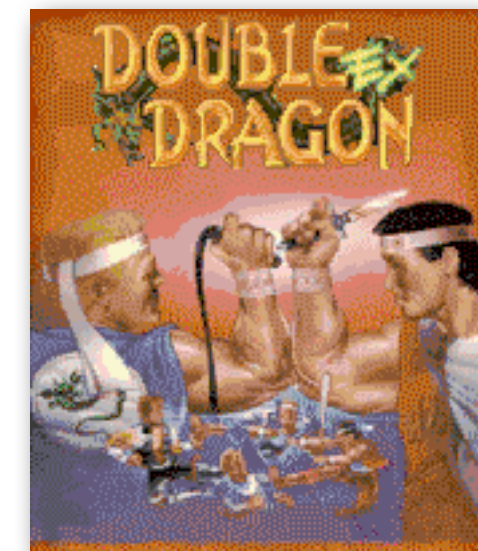
